Duties and Essential Job Functions:

- Create a purple carpet standard of service environment where stakeholders feel heard and cared for
- Provide peer support and guidance about housing options, processes, and on campus living experiences to prospective and current students
- Create and participate in department outreach efforts (social media, info sessions, experiences, tabling, etc.)
- Maintain positive working relationships with residents, parents, staff, and campus partners
- Navigate the StarRez database for administrative residential operations
- Monitor and respond to website chat function during assigned hours
- Screen and direct phone calls to the appropriate staff member or campus partner
- Participate in Ambassador express rotations to include deliveries to and from the Central Office
- Support RLH leadership team with administrative tasks and student follow-up
- Complete administrative and operation duties
- Attend and engage in all staff training and development efforts
- Attend monthly staff meetings and individual meetings (1-on-1s)
- Engage in formal and informal evaluations conducted by their supervisor
- Participate in the recruitment and selection processes for the following academic year
- Participate in priority department events (included but not limited to opening/closing procedures and housing selection/allocation days)
- Assist in care efforts from the department
- Other duties as assigned

Requirements:

- Must be an enrolled undergraduate student at TCU during the application process
- Must maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA and be in good academic standing
- Must be an undergraduate student with at least a year of college experience at TCU by August 2026
- Must be in good judicial standing with the University and the department of Housing and Residence Life
- Student account must be in good financial standing
- Must be able to commit to one full academic year beginning August 2026 and ending in May 2027
